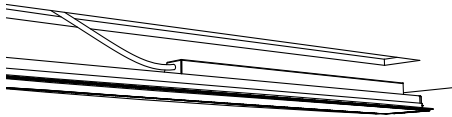


Mud In

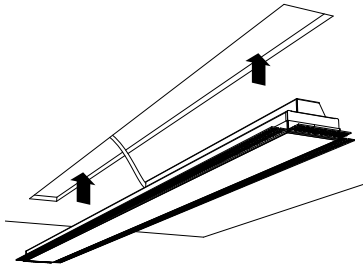
What to Know

Risk of fire and electrical shock. Installation requires knowledge of electrical systems and should be installed by a qualified electrician. If not qualified, **DO NOT ATTEMPT INSTALLATION**.

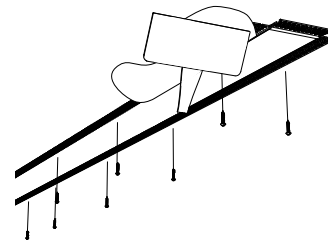
- 1 Connect power to the fixture. An enclosed driver box is provided which is fastened to the top of the fixture housing or loose for remote installation. Check to make sure you have a secure connection and that the fixture is wired correctly before moving to the next step. Refer to the wiring diagram.



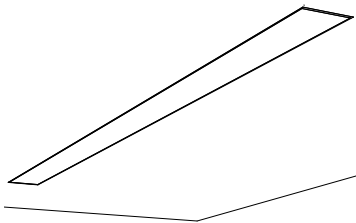
- 2 Raise the fixture to the mounting surface ensuring that the wires and fixture fit properly in its location.



- 3 Secure the fixture to the mounting surface with drywall screws. Once secured, ensure once again that the fixture is wired and working properly. Using the Mud-in flanges, prep the surface for paint.



- 4 Finish the surface as desired.



Care Instructions:

Wipe with a soft cloth only. Always avoid using harsh chemicals and/or cleaners.
